

A Report on One Day National Level Webinar on "Changing Dimensions Of Coparcenary Rights Of Daughters" organised on 19-11-2020.

Under the Hindu*succession Law during the ancient period, 'coparcenary' was the term used to denote a person, who assumes a legal rights in the ancestral property, by birth and these rights were granted only to male descendants i.e. sons. In 2005 amendments were taken up and section 6 of The Hindu Succession Act, 1956 granted equal rights to daughters like the sons by declaring that coparcener's daughter would become a coprcener in her own right by birth, in the same manner as the son. This amendment brought in the question as to whether the amended law would apply only to daughters born after 2005 and gave rise to civil cases relating to the coparcenary property. The judiciary in various cases had to interpret the question of coparcenary rights of daughters.

Hence a National Webinar on "The Changing Dimensions of Coparcenary Rights of Daughters" was organized on 19th November 2020 at 10-00 a.m. and the Resource Persons were Dr.Deevanshu Shrivastava, Head, Jagran School of Public Policy and International Affairs, Jagran Lakecity University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh and Dr. Babugouda Patil, Associate Professor, V.M. Salgaocar College of Law, Panaji, Goa.
